Devotional Homework Assignment

You will greatly benefit from “mining” the nuggets of truth from this passage on your own before session 2 of the retreat.

1. The word of God is all we need for life and godliness. In order to have proper context, please carefully read Prov. 2:1-22 in one sitting.
2. Focus on verses 1-5 and make a list of all the main verbs. These will give you the principles for Bible study
3. Carefully observe v. 6-8 and list the benefits God grants in response to someone who seeks to acquire godly wisdom.
4. The rest of this chapter lays out the “consequences” or results of applying oneself to embracing God’s word. Look carefully at each of the following sections, and make a list of what you learn:
 - Verses 9-11—“What you get”
 - Verses 12-19—“What you are delivered from”
 - Verses 20-22—“What you become”
5. Spend some time praying and meditating on these passages:
 - Ask God to reveal to you how you must change your habits, priorities, and walk to conform to His directives
 - Make a few notes of what you resolve to do in obedience to what you just learned and be ready to share with at least one person close to you who can keep you accountable... Just do it!
